Venue and Facilities

The venue for the conference is the **Gardens Point (city) campus of Queensland University of Technology** Brisbane. All sessions will be held in Z Block, a building set next to the Riverside Expressway. Registration will be in the 4th floor atrium.

All rooms and lecture theatres are fully equipped with audio-visual facilities, including data-projection capability for PowerPoint presentations or web-based demonstrations.

Information about Brisbane

Brisbane, a city of 1.5 million inhabitants, enjoys a subtropical climate. In October average daytime temperatures will be in the low to mid 20s. The inner city presents interesting contrasts between modern glass highrise, and buildings of local sandstone, all nestled within the curves of the meandering Brisbane River. A train runs from the airport to Central Station. QUT's Gardens Point Campus is within easy walking distance of the city centre, and a free bus service looping through the centre of the city stops outside the university gates
